- Wednesday, February 17, and Thursday February 18, the Zoo Guy, Michael Hicks, will be visiting CDS and bringing his array of critters for the kiddos to see. He will be here at 10:30 both days! We will also have a "Rodeo Lunch" on both of these days that will be school wide, so children will not need a lunch for that day unless they will not eat hot dogs, tater tots, beans, carrots, ranch dip and cookies for dessert!
- Fall 2010 Registration for existing families will start Monday, February 22. We will start promptly at 9:00 a.m. Enrollment packets will be sent home the week of February 16, 2010. Please remember to bring all your paperwork and updated immunization records to registration. Fees will not be increased the 2010-2011 school year. The registration fee is \$55 for the first child, \$35 for each additional child. Supply fees are \$60 per year per child for two days and \$100 per year per child for 4 days. For registration, you will need to be prepared to pay the registration fee and half of the supply fee. Tuition fees are as follows:

2 days/Nursery \$220 per month and 4 days/Nursery \$400 per month

2 days/All other ages \$200 per month and 4 days/All other ages \$360 per month

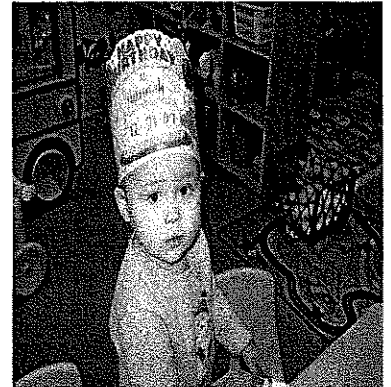
There is discounted tuition for active church members. Please see Sherry or Sarah for these rates.
